

Christian Giacomotto (born in 1940) is Chairman of the Board of Managing Partners of Gimar Finance. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Agence France-Muséums and chairs its audit committee.

He graduated in law (1962) and from the *Institut d'études politiques* in Paris (1963), after which he followed a postgraduate course of studies in American Finance at New York University (1976). He began his career at the Banque de l'Union Européenne (1965-1982) and was then appointed as Director of International Relations and Financing at Smith Barney in New York. He subsequently joined the CIC Group, where he occupied various functions before being appointed Managing Director (1984). He is presently Chairman of the Board of Managing Partners of Gimar Finance. He also chairs the regulatory authority for public auctions in France [*Conseil des ventes volontaires de meubles aux enchères publiques (CVV)*], and the association of friends of the *Musée national du Moyen-Age* (ARMMA). He is Vice Chairman of the Board of Directors of the *Réunion des musées nationaux* (RMN), and is also a member of the artistic council of the French national museums.
